Types of Data Collected

This website does not capture or retain any personal information from visitors. It will log a visitor's IP address and other data from your web browser. This may include the browser you are using, your device's operating system and the address of any website that referred you to this site. This is used to produce anonymous web statistics for use in planning the future offering of our services, including the operation of this website.

However, the website will record and process personally identifiable data if you provide this when using the site, for example, when completing a contact form and entering your contact details.

What we do with your data

Disclosure of Information to Third Parties

We may also disclose Personal Data if we are required to do so in order to comply with any applicable legal, regulatory, or other statutory requirement.

Cookies

This website uses "cookie" technology. A cookie is a small file stored by the browser on your computer at the request of our server.

Two types of cookies are use, *persistent* and *session*. Persistent cookies remain on your device until their set expiry date (or if you delete them before that date) and are sent back to this website by your browser identifying you as a returning visitor.
